At the same time, other HDA national teams such as the educational, financial, communications, international dentists, iournal, research, and executive committees are working to give us a great 2024 Annual Meeting in White Plains on June 21 and 22, 2024. We will "honor the past and embrace the future" this year during our academic events. This version will have participation of more than 30 experts, including speakers and panelists, providing a thematic update in general and specialized areas of dentistry and professional development.

Likewise, we are honored and excited by the two grants the two HDA teams recently received. The service and outreach team received a 250k grant from the Delta Dental Foundation to strengthen and expand the BOLD program nationwide. Additionally, the research team received a fourth grant CareQuest, reaching milestone of 1 million of dollars for the HDA Research Initiative 2021-2024. These two significant efforts of the HDA are focused on strengthening our voice in achieving more equitable oral health and improving access to health services and studies in dental programs by our Hispanic minorities.

Also, starting this year, the Hispanic Dental Foundation announced a milestone it has been working towards since 1990: awarding One Million Dollars in Hispanic Dental Scholarships to support Hispanic Students in dental, dental hygiene, dental residencies, and advanced standing programs.

This March, we begin by celebrating Share a Smile Day and will also be celebrating several important days, such as Dental Assistants Recognition Week and National Dentist Day. Likewise, we extend a special greeting to all Hispanic women in dentistry who represent us in the best way every day in this Women's History Month.





Colgate Oral Pharmaceuticals, Inc. and The Hispanic Dental Association (HDA) invite you to participate in Nuestros Niños, a program designed to address oral health care issues. including prevention and oral care strategies for Hispanic children less than 18 years of age. Students are invited to present a case study with a Hispanic pediatric patient. This case study should include: full medical and dental history, restorative and periodontal charting, radiographic images, models, all diagnostic tools used to develop the treatment plan, complete the treatment plan, preventive treatment, oral hygiene recommendations and patient outcomes.

All patient images, names, contact information, and identifiers must be blocked or deleted to mask the identity of the patient to comply with HIPAA. If required, also submit consent release forms signed by the parent or patient prior to submission.

\$5,000 will be awarded to the winning case study and \$3,000 to the runner up student with the case studies that most closely meet the criteria. The two student awardees, along with one faculty advisor from each school, will receive funding to attend the Hispanic Dental Association Student Regional Meeting on June 20 2024 at the NYU School of Dentistry - NYC, NY. The winners will present their case studies during the meeting. The trip portion of the prize may be canceled without liability or substitution of another prize if Sponsor reasonably believes such termination or change is advisable due to the COVID-19 pandemic, or if the HDA meeting is canceled or postponed.

Chapters will also receive \$500. Students must be members of the HSDA and the faculty advisors must be members of the HDA.

HSDA students must submit their final case study to HDA by May 3, 2024 for consideration. The submission should include a written report with charts and used. Please submit images membership@hdassoc.org.

Submissions will be reviewed by a panel of judges consisting of HDA members and Colgate employees and be evaluated on the following criteria; 1) thoroughness of dental evaluation and treatment plan (30%), 2) consideration of cultural and socioeconomic factors





A special thank you to HDA International Dentist member, Dr. Yuliana Alzate Narajo, for answering the call for a Spanish speaker to present to this elementary school with over 95% Hispanic children.

The 2nd and 3rd graders learned about brushing, flossing and meal portions. Volunteers explained the exclusive lunch box and carrot case. They tag-teamed to translate English to Spanish, and offered a show and tell description of the braille ligands on the carrot case that read, "Dental Care in a Carrot."
