HDA President Message

"Pioneers of Change: Shaping the Future Together"



It is time to celebrate the Hispanic Heritage Month! We honor our ancestors' history, culture, and invaluable contributions. We recognize

the significant role that Hispanic and Latino people have played, not only in the United States but also in the broader Hispanic world. Their contributions have shaped our history and culture, and we celebrate their achievements with pride.

The Hispanic Heritage Month (HHM) observation started in 1968 as Hispanic Heritage Week under President Lyndon Johnson and was expanded by President Ronald Reagan in 1988 to cover a 30-day period. The HHM begins on September 15th because several Latin American countries celebrate their independence on that day. For example, Mexico celebrates its independence on September 16th, and Chile celebrates its independence on September 18th.

The Hispanic Dental Association (HDA) theme for this year's HHM is "Honoring the past, Embracing the future." The HDA embraces and celebrates this year's theme by celebrating that Hispanic people have been part of the United States' history since before the American colonization and the American Revolution, and showcasing their significant contributions to the country as writers, scientists, soldiers, doctors, entrepreneurs, academics, and leaders.

Each HHM marks a remarkable stride made by our Hispanic community in economics, politics, societal advancement, and well-being. The Hispanic Dental Association (HDA) has been a driving force in these efforts, actively working to achieve greater equity and justice in oral health services. Through our initiatives in outreach, professional development, research, publications, international dentists, educational, communications, and advocacy, we strive to promote opportunities and equal access in Oral Health, empowering our community for a healthier future.

Regarding honoring the past, the HDA recognizes our roots and the significant role of Hispanic and Latino people in dentistry, publishing recent historical research about the first Hispanic Women in Dentistry in all Spanish-speaking countries. We will also publish



the traces of the **first Hispanic dentists in the United States**. This incoming publication will be a great achievement for our profession and our ethnicity, allowing us to honor the pioneers of our profession in these lands, how they forged the path for those who came later, and how we can learn by their leadership example as a guide for future generations. Equally, we have been recognizing the efforts of our past presidents and collaborating teams for almost 35 years, since we could not be where we are if they had not paved our way.

Besides embracing the future, our 9th edition of the Journal of the Hispanic Dental Association (JHDA), "Workforce: Challenges and Opportunities," and the incoming 10th JHDA edition, "Policy Changes in Oral Health: An Engagement Path," are a seedbed to strengthen the advocacy efforts and changes that our communities need. Likewise, our 2022-2024 workshops and research publications showing the current trends in oral health for US Hispanics are the better approach for data-driven policymaking for policy changes in oral health. These efforts help us support marginalized communities and educate our leaders about dismantling systemic inequalities for better health outcomes.

Our commitment to the future of Hispanic leadership in dentistry is unwavering. All our HDA outreach programs, including Building our Leaders in Dentistry (BOLD), Care of US, Serving Our Heroes/Sirviendo Nuestros Heroes Veterans programs, HDA Bringing Smiles Health fairs, Bilingual resources for oral health providers, e-learning platform, and our pathway Community Leadership Fellowship program (CLF), are primarily focused on training and empowering the next generation of Hispanic leaders in dentistry. We believe in their potential and are dedicated to nurturing their skills and knowledge.

Dr. Meiners is the 4th female, 4th Hispanic, and 4th from her South Texas hometown region of the Rio Grande Valley to win this award since it began in 1965.
