
















### **Inclusive Play Matters:**

Innovating Outdoor Play Destinations for People of All Ages and Abiilities

### Can a playground be accessible and inclusive? What are the differences? What makes them different? Aren't they the same?

No, think about it, accessible just means that children and adults can access certain components of a playground. For example, a transfer platform allows children to approach the platform to lift themselves up and get on the playground equipment. Think about that though, does every child have the ability to lift themselves up???

A playground that is inclusive is heavily designed and it's elements include multiple levels of engagement. Thankfully, Jennie, a CORE Community Outreach Director, guided us through the 7 principles of Inclusive Playground Design. Jennie gave us examples of the playground elements that are considered accessible yet do not provide value to children who may have disabilities. In summary, do research before you design a playground for everyone. Think about the five senses and include elements that utilize them. If this is done correctly, a playground will be exciting and engaging for all visitors.


